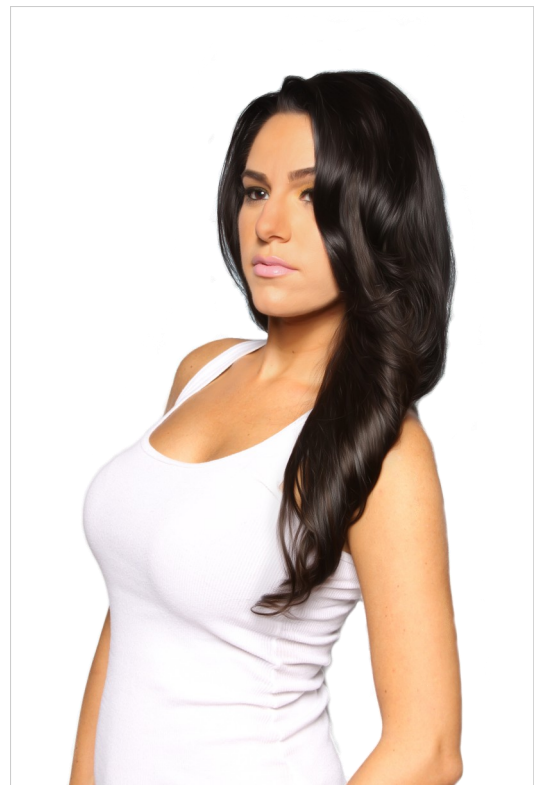

## **Clip-in Remy Hair Extensions:**

Inhairco's high quality clip-in hair extensions naturally blend in and are the best and fastest way to add volume and length to your hair. For a customized look, these versatile extensions can be colored, curled and flat ironed

## **The Weft.**

Hand-tied wefts per their name are done by hand and tend to be much thinner than machine wefts. They are excellent for sew in weaves and lay flat against your scalp to give a more natural look. This significantly reduces hair bumps caused by bulky wefts. Hand-tied wefts come in approximately twenty (20) to twenty-four (24) inch wide pieces, with four (4) to five (5) pieces per pack. All of our wefts are reinforced to prevent shedding. Please Note\* to preserve the integrity of the hair, hand-tied wefts should not be cut. Never push the needle through the weft; it is best to sew around the weft.

## Recent Features:



Good genes, a kick-ass stylist...every star with an amazing head of hair has both, right? Perhaps. But many now have another potent asset: a closetful of someone else's pristine locks. Extensions are officially everywhere, and barring pixies, just about everyone on the red carpet has them. "More and more stars are wearing them on a permanent basis," says stylist Kristina Barricelli, who has worked with Vanessa Hudgens. Wonder how these hair helpers could transform (or just beef up) your own strands? You grow, girl!

### If you have fine or normal hair, try... **EXTENSIONS**

Sometimes called keratin-bonded extensions, these strands of synthetic or human hair are typically applied with heat and a matching colored adhesive. Results range from a subtle infusion of volume to an entirely new do, and it costs \$400 to \$3,000. To nail the look, follow this expert advice.

#### CHOOSE THE RIGHT PROCESS

Talk to your stylist about what kind of hair is going in, and how he or she is applying it. Placing wide sections of hair (mounted on wefts) below your own "can give you a thicker look but won't work for anything more than a low ponytail," says Barricelli, co-owner of New York's Gemini 14 salon. A strand-by-strand application of a top salon brand like Great Lengths or She by So Cap can make both subtle or dramatic changes look more natural, since strands are sandwiched around your own. Microbonds, added judiciously wherever needed, are sometimes used to compensate for thinning hair at the temples.

**CONSIDER COLOR** The key to achieving believability—beyond using human hair—is mixing tones, says Barricelli. "A seamless look comes from blending in different shades." If you're not choosing hair at a salon, purchase two shades of hair to try together.

**BOOK MORE TIME** Once your stylist has heat-bonded your new hair, he or she will likely need to cut and style it to

achieve the best match between born-with and borrowed.

**TREAT THEM RIGHT** Avoid clarifying shampoos or any formulas with sulfates, which can dry out extensions. Also skip conditioners with a high silicone content, as these can create slippage around the bonds. After applying a product such as Kerastase's Masque Force Architecte (\$67, kerastase-usa.com) from mid-shaft to ends, use a detangling brush (we like Great Lengths' paddle brushes, \$34-\$60; getgreatlengths.com for salons) to avoid pulling hair.

**TAKE 'EM OUT ON TIME** Damage is typically caused not by getting extensions but by leaving them in too long, or by yanking out strands on your own instead of having a pro dissolve the bonds with the correct solution. "The key with extensions is to pay attention to their stability. Once they get unstable, they're liable to damage your hair," says Barricelli. For those with a fine texture, the life of their faux hair may be as short as two months; thicker hair can tolerate the add-ons for up to five months.

## If you have thick, coarse, or curly hair, try a... WEAVE

This technique offers serious makeover potential: Your own strands are braided into cornrows that can be totally hidden by new hair. But it isn't as all-or-nothing as many people think, notes Cesar Ramirez, who works with Clira. "A full weave, with the crown section of your hair left out, can actually look the most natural," he says. These extensions do take time to put in (two to six hours), but they also provide a break from heat styling or relaxers.

**SHOP CAREFULLY** Forged up with locks you can restyle easily and wash without excessive tangling, choose unprocessed, or "virgin," human hair from a well-known retailer (See "Where to Buy," left). Otherwise, you risk the stinging but first-strand-damaging from breakers, glues, or acid bath and other caustic, wet silicone. Also, says Ramirez, pick new strands "in a texture that looks believable."

**CONSIDER YOUR PART** Whether you want it at the side or center, with or without bangs, the placement of your part will determine how your hair is braided. With a full weave, you're locked into the choice once cornrows are done.

**CARE FOR YOUR OWN HAIR** Once a week, you'll need to gingerly slick up your braids under the weave, gently scrubbing the scalp with a rice-based shampoo and conditioner. To avoid any snags, blow-dry with a

diffuser, which holds a better job of reaching the scalp than a regular nozzle. Finally, minimize beverage around the crown and sides of your head, sip on a sack pillowcase and work lanes all into your routine weekly, says (Frisco, Texas), ex-founder and creative director of Indirect Hair.

**RESPECT THE EXPIRATION DATE** You'll get two, maybe three, months wear from a weave. As your own hair begins to grow in, not only will your do start to look "puffy near the roots," says Ramirez, but any tangles where the weave is sewn into your cornrows can also cause stress and breakage to your own strands.

**STORE THEM WELL** Retired-quality hair can often be used repeatedly. To maintain it in an easily reusable condition, the manufacturer recommends zipping the tracks to a ziploc bag and storing them in a cool, dry place.

### WHERE TO BUY

You'll pay \$129 to \$210 for 4 ounces, and the selection includes remy hair highlighted to shades of blond.

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## If you have commitment issues, try... CLIP-INS

Can you say "party look"? Whether you want passable oomph for your ponytail or a temporary take on major fringe, clip-ins offer a huge transformation at a fraction of the cost (and time) that it takes to get more permanent extensions. But these pieces, which also include less-obvious uniparticulars, are only short-term accessory and should be treated that way. "Some people think clip-ins will be less damaging, and they wear them instead of getting permanent extensions. But if you wear these day after day, it can put stress on your natural hair," says Baricelli.

### BANGS

**AVOID THE GLAZE** Chances are you'll be purchasing fringe made from synthetic fibers. If you're going for the look of bangs, says Baricelli, who created the line shown below, says none is as fine, but too much looks so cheap on a clip-in as it does on a suit.

**KNOW THAT SIZE MATTERS** We found that budget clip-ins looked more child than adult-size and didn't offer enough bangs. Bangs with longer, more generous side pieces can also be worth a higher price tag since they help fringe blend and add volume to hair overall. Also check that there are three or more snags to help secure hair.

**PREPARE YOUR OWN STYLING** Just as Cesar Ramirez, who works with Lashley Lopez, likes the "modern mannequin look" of combining empty rhinestones with clip-in bangs, "don't use glue together with a separate headband."

**FINE THE SWEET SPOT** The most common positioning mistake is placing fringe too far forward. "For a kind of lift from the hair, it's better to place it just behind the hairline," says Baricelli. But you also don't want to add a shelf so far back onto the crown that

"you look like you're wearing a canopy." Once you've found the natural resting spot, have a stylist trim bangs to customize a natural look.

**KEEP UP ON THE HAIR** Signaling stress at the crown head bangs can fracture, says Baricelli. But even if you don't backcomb, bangs vs. better bangs usually snap into hair too late for a haircut.

### PONYTAIL

**PREP YOUR OWN HAIR** If you've purchased dead-end straight-but-your own hair, you'll need to blow-dry so that hair matches yours.

**ACHIEVE STABILITY** Before a clip-in is attached into (and around) your own hair, ensure that your base is secure. Baricelli recommends a hooked elastic and playing it safe with positioning. "If you don't normally wear a high ponytail, this is not designed to win."

**HAVE A PARTY** Tails are slightly trickier to put in than bangs. You have to wrap hair around your own ponytail, secure it with a comb, and



Factor in a Webby team. (Better versions include an extra strand of hair to wrap around the base.) Once it's in, wear it at home long enough to check for any gaps or tugging. **STYLE AND WASH** It's fine to put products like shine spray on your do. Just make any clip-in hair last for three to four washes with diluted shampoo. Follow up with diluted conditioner, a good but gentle rinse, and a dryer.
